Programme Structure

1. The programme shall include three types of courses : Core courses, Electives courses and Audit Courses.
2. Project Work / Dissertation and Comprehensive Viva-voce is mandatory for all regular and private registration students.
3. Study Tour may be conducted as a part of the Programme in 3 rd Semester. (For the students of Affiliated Colleges only, not for SDE/Private Students.
4. Audit Course – Two Audit Courses with 4 credits each have to be done one each in the first and second semesters. The credit will not be counted for evaluating the overall SGPA & CGPA. Student has to obtain only minimum pass requirements in this examination.

Eligibility criteria for Admission

MA Tamil(Language and Literature)

Under Mark System :- BA Tamil (Main) Degree with at least 50% marks for Part III or BA/B Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Tamil in Part II with at least 50% marks of this University or equivalent degree. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

Under Grade System :- BA Tamil (Core) Degree or BA/B Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Tamil Common Course of this University or equivalent degree with each Core and Complementary course grade point at least equivalent to 50%. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

PROJECT WORK /DISSERTATION & COMPREHENSIVE VIVA-VOCE

1. There shall be Project work with dissertation and Comprehensive viva-voce as separate courses relating to the core area under study in the end semester and included in the Core Courses.

2. For Regular students, Project work is mandatory for all faculties but Comprehensive Viva-voce is optional. Viva-voce related to Project work shall be one of the criteria for project Work evaluation provided as per 18.6 of this regulation.
3. SDE/Private Registration students can opt for either Project Work or one Theory Course. Comprehensive Viva-voce is optional. These shall be in accordance with the decisions and stipulations of the concerned BoS.
4. If the SDE/Private registration students opt Project Work, it can be done only under the supervision of a working/retired teacher from a Govt/Aided College or a University teacher and prior approval/sanction from the SDE has to be obtained as per the stipulations of the concerned programme curriculum.
5. The combined Credit for the Project Work and Comprehensive Viva-voce shall not be more than 8(eight) credit subject to a minimum of 4(four) credit for Project Work.
6. All students have to submit a Project Report/Dissertation in the prescribed structure and format as a part of the Project Work undertaken as per the stipulations of the concerned BoS
7. There shall be External and Internal evaluation for Project Work and these shall be combined in the proportion of 4:1. In the case of Comprehensive Viva-voce, the conduct of External Viva-voce is mandatory but internal is optional, subject to the decision and stipulations of the BoS concerned.
8. Detailed course structure on Project work to be done, Viva-voce and Project Report preparation can be designed by integrating relevant aspects by the concerned Board of Studies of the Programme.
9. Details of evaluation of Project Work/Dissertation and Comprehensive Viva-voce are given under clause 18 of this regulation.
