Anti Ragging Cell

The duties of the anti-ragging cell will be to keep watch and put an end to any instances of ragging that might occur or be reported in areas where students congregate, such as classrooms, canteens, buses, grounds, hostels, etc. By using a variety of strategies, the members will also inform the entire student body about the dangers of ragging and the associated penalties. The Anti-Ragging cell uses a variety of positive reinforcement techniques to help students find their way and shape their personalities for the better. On August 8, 2022, the Anti-Ragging Cell was reconstituted. The committee taught the students about legal awareness. The anti-ragging committee and squad have frequent meetings to educate new students about their rights and to provide them with clear anti-ragging instructions. A faculty member assigned new students from each department, and he or she will speak with each one individually each day to find out if there are any issues at the college, the hostel, etc. Students who have been involved in or seen ragging incidents are encouraged to report the incident. To raise awareness among students about anti-ragging, posters with the rules and regulations are posted in the college campus, including the notice board, departments, common areas, the canteen, the library and hostels. Students received general ragging education from committee members. Circulation of SAY NO TO RAGGING postures with details of ragging alert cell phone number were done through whatsapp groups. No complaints were raised during academic year 2022-2023.
